

HyperFlex Specialization Requirements

To earn the Cisco HyperFlex Specialization, partner must meet the role requirements below. In some cases, one person can fill more than one role. See the <u>Role-Sharing Guidelines</u> (PDF) for details.

Role requirements

The Hyperflex Specialization has one mandatory role – systems engineer. We highly recommend that account managers also complete training, but it is not required.

Systems Engineer (SE)

A minimum of two SEs are required for this specialization.

Can one specialization apply across different countries? Yes, but only within one country grouping.

Role sharing

Can one person fill more than one role? It depends. See <u>Role-Sharing Guidelines</u> (PDF - 59 KB).

No role sharing in allowed within the Specialization. Two unique individuals are required to fill the roles.
